- **SIGN UP** for Otter Tail County's alert & warning system on the county website.

### Watch

A severe storm possible in your area. Be alert to changing weather conditions.



#### Warning

A severe storm headed for your area. Seek shelter now! Do not leave shelter until the warning has expired or been canceled.





# WHEN SEVERE WEATHER ARRIVES

- WHEN THUNDER ROARS, GO INDOORS.® A sturdy building is the safest place to be during severe weather.
- **GET TO SHORE** and find a shelter immediately if boating or swimming.
- if your community, resort, or campground has one.
- GET TO A SMALL INTERIOR ROOM ON THE LOWEST LEVEL if you are in a building with no basement.
- **YOU ARE SAFER IN A LOW, FLAT LOCATION** than under an overpass or bridge, where a wind tunnel may develop.
- ➤ TURN AROUND. DON'T DROWN!®
  Just six inches of fast-moving water can knock you down, and one foot of moving water can sweep your vehicle away.
- **LISTEN TO LOCAL RADIO & AUTHORITIES** for updated information.
